

## Tour 5 - Farm, Field and Forest Loop - 20.8 miles

Some of the most pleasant country roads around are found among the rolling hills and farms of the Maine/New Hampshire border. Here, the roads dart between the two states. The atmosphere is rural and the scenery changes from fields to mountain vistas.

The beauty of this ride is that it has some of the most gentle roads in the area. There are a few rolling hills (particularly on Green Hill Road), but nothing terribly demanding. See if you can find the reversing hill section of the ride. Looks like you are going up hill but the pedaling is easy.

Green Hill Road is the forest portion of the ride, while Route 113 is the farm and field section. There are potato and corn fields, stone walls, weathered barns, the old Saco River and mountain vistas. For a novice rider looking to step up to intermediate this one's for you.
