

Tour 13 - Famous Maine Signpost Ride - 58.1 miles

As resorts developed in the 1800's, somebody must have had a good time naming the towns. This ride passes one of the iconic images of Western Maine: a tall signpost pointing every which way, with a jumble of foreign-and-domestic town names.

You also pass through the high apple orchards of Sweden. Waterford is as pretty now as in its heyday as a secret getaway for 1940's Hollywood stars.

There are a number of significant climbs on this ride.
