

# Tour 8 - Harpswell Fine Arts & Crafts Ride - 33.8 miles

Harpswell, renowned for having the longest coastline of any town in the USA, also abounds with fine art and craft studios. Besides seeing majestic views of Casco Bay along the peninsula, we will visit fiber artists, art galleries, a porcelain jewelry studio and a pottery studio. We will also see how fine furniture is made and visit the Earthheart Gardens and see their world famous Japanese Irises. Authentic working waterfronts, seafood takeout & lunch restaurants as well as the oldest town meetinghouse in Maine will be additional highlights of this ride. An alternative start point for a shorter ride ~ 20 miles, is to drive to the Harpswell Grange Hall just south of Rt. 123 & Mountain Rd and join riders from Brunswick HS ~9:15 am.
