

Tour 23 - Cradle of Ships - 36.7 miles

Enter Bath from the south end and travel up Washington St. Visit the Maine Marine Museum where some of the largest wooden ships in the world were built. Travel past Bath Iron Works which helped end WWII and continues to supply the Navy with the best ships built. Return by visiting the largest bison farm in Maine, then the Androscoggin Bike Path.
