

Tour 11a - Androscoggin Bound - 64.4 miles

Roll through the narrowest notch in the White Mountains to the edge of a pond rimmed by alpine scenery. This advanced excursion tackles Evans Notch, a winding mountain road with copious tree canopies, from both directions. Much of the ride is on wiggling Route 113 which dances between Maine and New Hampshire.

Farms, potato fields and the Saco River. There is opportunity to stop in for a swim along the river, get some chocolate milk from a farm stand and pop into a country store.

The Basin, in the White Mountain National Forest, is a spot to cool off, or have a picnic. This is an out and back ride.
