

Tour 21 - Raising 'cane - 24.3 miles

Hurricane Mountain Road's a killer. In these parts, some roads are closed in winter. This steep, winding road is one of them. Too tough to plow, perhaps. Hurricane Mountain Road includes a nearly two mile stretch with an eleven percent grade, shorter stretches up to 16-17%. Ouch. The downhill side's steep too, so make sure the brakes are working.

From Fryeburg, the ride is a rural pedal, but also goes quickly by a busy section of North Conway, New Hampshire with a few big box retailer stores. North Conway village is a short block away at spots for those who want to take some local culture, and the ride passes near the village's in-town ski area of Mount Cranmore.
